SUMMARY: This Memorandum requests that the Director be authorized to execute an

Engineering Services Contract for the Playground and Park, Parcel No. 5, Charlestown, MA project in Charlestown Navy Yard for a total cost not to exceed Seventy Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$75,000.00) with

Weston & Sampson Engineers, Inc., of Boston, MA

BACKGROUND

The Capital Construction Department as requested, and due to time constraints, assigned to the Licensed Site Professional of Record for the Boston Redevelopment Authority ("BRA"), Weston & Sampson Engineers, Inc. the environmental engineering design and administration for pre-drilling program and soil sampling program at the proposed Playground/Park, Parcel No. 5, Charlestown, MA in the Charlestown Navy Yard.

The goal of the Playground and Park, Parcel No. 5 project is intended to assist the City of Boston within the requested Mayor's initiative to provide activity space to compliment the activities at the Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital exterior site with a playground and park, and that these new amenities offer a high level of safe play value and therapeutic benefits similar to those within the facility, and are of accessible design. The proposed site will provide a significant enhancement to the Navy Yard/Hospital community and would round out the overall recreational use of the pier. The project is intended to be a public/private partnership and consist of several phases. This Phase 1 (public) is to provide for environmental assessment and remediation requirements under the Mass DEP Chapter 21E Contingency Plan.

FUNDING

Consultant services will be funded from 2012-2013 General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Director be authorized to a enter into a Engineering Services Contract with Weston & Sampson Engineers, Inc., at a cost not to exceed Seventy Five Thousand, Dollars and Zero Cents (\$75,000.00) for environmental engineering services for the Playground and Park, Parcel No. 5, Charlestown, Massachusetts.
