Goal: As a team, work together to create a land use vision for the Study Area that shows what areas should be preserved and where land use changes could happen.

Land use regulates what activities someone can do on a piece of unbuilt land or a building on their land. People use land and the buildings on the land for housing, places to shop, working, etc.


Step 1: Discuss

Discuss **existing conditions** of the land uses in the neighborhood.




Step 2: Sketch

Draw areas on the map where you would like to see **preserved** and areas expected to see **change**.



Step 3: Envision

What land use goes where? Place down land use blocks on the map, one land use at a time.



Land Use Colors



Shopping & Services (auto service, grocery, dry cleaner, restaurant, retail, etc.)

Orange



Cultural & Civic (gallery, community space, education/training)



Green

Open Space (parks, plazas, green roofs, rain gardens, playgrounds, etc.)



Commercial (offices, wholesale)

Red



Housing (apartments, singlefamily houses, tripledeckers, etc.)



21st-century Industrial (maker space, microbrewery, low-impact industrial uses that are clean and are less disturbing to neighbors)

White


Number of blocks do not represent height. Blocks do not represent any unit of space, and final block counts are illustrative only.


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
Example Scenario Concepts




"I want this space to be **mixed use** with residential above and ground floor services"






