- More nearby supportive commercial spaces and amenities







Scenario 1

The Strand is preserved in its current configuration at 1400 seats.

The library will include a special space for creative programming.

Scenario 2

The Strand is reconfigured to include additional spaces for creative and cultural programming.

The library will include a special space for creative programming.

Scenario 3

The Strand is substantially restructured to include space for other creative and cultural programming and is physically connected to the Library to create a cluster of many activated spaces.
