

Assessing What We Heard & Next Steps Workshop Summary

May 16 2016

The purpose of this workshop was to discuss what we heard at the open house, walking tour, and previous workshops and to review the next steps of the planning process.

OPEN HOUSE AND NETWORKING

Prior to the start of the workshop, staff from the BRA and City of Boston spoke with workshop participants. Several informational presentation boards were displayed from the open house and previous workshops.

WELCOME AND UPDATE

Lara Merida, Deputy Director of Community Planning, welcomed participants and gave a brief presentation. She reviewed the goals of the PLAN: Dudley Square study and provided an update to the schedule for the next several workshops. SMALL GROUP EXERCISE

Small groups gathered to review the comments and ideas that have been received to date. The feedback had been organized in a chart and displayed in two categories: items that can be addressed through development requirements for publicly-owned land that is put out for development and items that will need to be addressed through other partnerships (City of Boston departments, other government agencies, non-profits, community and/or other organizations). Facilitators asked participants to make revisions to any of the comments and to add additional feedback they felt was missing.
