






















The stepped curvilinear façade of the corner **Commonwealth Building** captures the energy of the bustling Kenmore Square intersection while also making a formal deferential gesture to the Citgo Sign.

The new midblock **Beacon Building** responds to both the scale and massing of the buildings on either side of it. The street façade can be seen as a contemporary abstraction of its neighbors while serving to stitch the buildings together through the horizontal alignment of the cornices and belt courses.
