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
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
#### **EOEEA Secretary's Conditions:**

- A minimum 50% open space on all major development sites
- o Maximum building heights of 240-270 feet
- Building massing and waterfront setbacks to limit shadow impacts on Fan Pier Cove
- Harborwalk along the entirety of the waterfront
- Provisions for Facilities of Public
   Accommodation on all ground floors
- o 127,000 SF of civic and cultural space
- A minimum of one third residential use on new development sites
- o Water transportation facilities and subsidies

- Expand World Trade Center Terminal capacity – primary hub
- New or expand docks at : Children's Museum, Courthouse, Fan Pier Cove, Wharf 8 and Pier 1
- Improve terminals and landside intermodal connections
- Innovative public and private funding mechanisms and terminal management








## **Open Space and Recreation Plan**

- Harbor Islands Gateway have the area serve as an additional point of access to the Harbor Islands









## **Fort Point Channel Watersheet Activation Plan**
