The purpose of this letter is to notify the Boston Redevelopment Authority ("BRA") of the intent of GTI Properties (the "Project Proponent"), the proposed developer of the property located at 755 Harrison Avenue, Boston, MA (the "Property"), to file with the BRA to renovate the site containing the former Church of the Immaculate Conception (the "Church") and the so-called "Link Building" into residential housing with approximately fifty-eight (58) rental units (the "Proposed Project").
