Dear Secretary Golden:

On behalf of Jamestown 21-23-25 Drydock, L.P. and Jamestown 1 Design Place, L.P., and in accordance with the Mayor's Executive Order relative to the provision of mitigation by development projects in Boston, I am pleased to submit this Letter of Intent under Article 80B of the Boston Zoning Code for The Innovation and Design Building in the Boston Marine Industrial Park ("BMIP").

The proposed project (the "Project") is located on Parcel F (the "Boston Design Center") located at One Design Center Place and Parcel I (the "Bronstein Center") located at 21, 23, and 25 Drydock Avenue (collectively, the "Property") in South Boston. The Property currently contains two physically connected, eight-story buildings. The Project will include improvements to the existing buildings' infrastructure and mechanical systems; parking, loading, access, and other site and façade improvements, together with new signage. The Project will accommodate a wider range of commercial office uses in the Bronstein Building, in addition to the existing industrial office and warehouse uses. The Project will also add leasable area in new kiosks structures located on the north side of the Property and a greenhouse or other urban agriculture use on the rooftop.

The Project will retain the historic appearance of the existing buildings and complement the surrounding maritime uses while positioning The Innovation and Design Building as a commercial and light industrial activity center in the BMIP.
