**RE: 361 Belgrade Ave Development Project - on a deed-restricted parcel - REJECT this Project!**

Dear Mayor Walsh:

We want to share important information about the proposed Development Project at 355-361-371 Belgrade Ave, which includes three (3) parcels of land in the City of Boston.

**Two neighborhoods** are involved in this project: these parcels are deeded in West Roxbury, [www.boston.gov/neighborhoods](http://www.boston.gov/neighborhoods) calls it: "A **friendly** suburban community in Boston," and the land is zoned in Roslindale, called: "A neighborhood with plenty of **beauty and charm**."

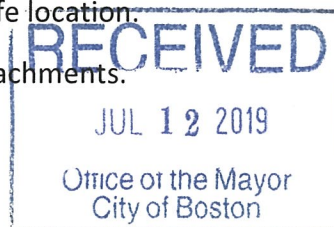
The Proponent's Project Development Team has deflected answering questions about the Development Project and its Proponent, focusing instead on the success of the School, which will occupy the proposed building. Due to this deceptive strategy, the Proponent Team has chosen to advance its agenda by mischaracterizing our neighborhoods, causing its supporters to use defamatory language in describing members of our community. We **STRONGLY** reject and condemn its unethical tactics, which has provoked a hostile environment in our (and your) once friendly Neighborhoods. In addition, the Proponent Team has misrepresented the community support of the project.

We, the members of three Civic Associations and our neighbors, all agree we have the right to **transparent Community Engagement**, but the **City of Boston has failed us**. Therefore, we recommend that you **OPPOSE** this Project, and show the voters of Ward 20 that we can count on your leadership.

We **OPPOSE this Development Project** for the following reasons:

- A. **Lack of TRANSPARENCY by the City**, which withheld information from the involved neighborhoods.
- B. **Lack of a COMPARABLE SITE-SEARCH by the Proponent**, who, instead, selected a site at a dangerous intersection on a deed-restricted parcel.
- C. **Lack of HONESTY by the Proponent to its own Students/Parents/Faculty/Staff**, who are the losers and have been asked to settle for a sub-standard and unsafe location.

Background for the following points will be in the forth coming packet of Attachments.



**A. LACK OF TRANSPARENCY BY THE CITY:**

- A.1. The City has **not transparently identified the Proponent, Roxbury Prep Belgrade Ave, LLC**. Only mention of the Charter School is made during public meeting, making the LAND acquisition **blurry**, and the validity of the PERMIT/APPEAL documents questionable.
- A.2. **Neighborhood Services claimed no knowledge** of a sign posted by ISD, referring to the Appeal of the Proponent's variance violation, **but then approved** the Appeal Hearing request for scheduling, apparently **against procedure**.
- A.3. Different departments within the City repeatedly **provide conflicting information**.
- A.4. BPDA has participated in meetings but has **not satisfactorily answered our questions**.

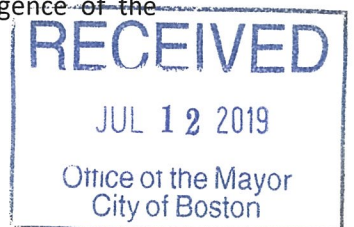
**B. LACK OF A COMPARABLE SITE-SEARCH FOR A SAFE SITE:**

What is so essential about this group of parcels, which encourages an organization, dedicated to ACADEMICS, to "shoe-horn" its deserving students into an undersized facility, in an unsafe location, after dramatically scaling-down the project size and student population, with no educational rationale?

- B.1. **Why is the selected site IM-PROPERLY SIZED?** This site is TOO SMALL to accommodate all the promises made to the Students for a State of the Art School.
- B.2. **Why is the selected site NOT SAFE?** A nearby rotary is the hub to a major 4-lane roadway (Centre Street) and a major parkway (West Roxbury Parkway), making the Belgrade Ave. intersection a traffic nightmare: confusing, congested, dangerous, and unsafe.
- B.3. **Why is the selected site in an area which the MBTA tells us does NOT HAVE THE CAPACITY within their system** to accommodate the additional 600 passengers?
- B.5. **Why is the selected site on land which likely has environmental risks**, due to probable oil dumping, where Classrooms are proposed below grade-level?
- B.6. **Why is the selected site where the only OUTDOOR land is on a deed-restricted parcel**, which the proposal violates by installing a Courtyard?
- B.7. **Why is the selected site full of** variance violations?

**C. LACK OF HONESTY BY THE PROJECT DEVELOPMENT TEAM** was demonstrated by:

- C.1. Dramatically down-sizing the building and functionality, with **no educational rationale**,
- C.2. Shoe-horning the facility into this plot of land, ensuring that the students would **not get the STEAM capabilities** which had been **PROMISED**,
- C.3. [Roxbury Prep Trustee Board] **Violating Public Meeting Laws** by a) improperly holding an Executive Session and b) excluding a parent from a Board Meeting,
- C.4. **Negatively portraying our neighborhoods** with a smear campaign by the PR Firm which, at one time on its website, described its mission as: "We help projects get through neighborhood opposition," and
- C.5. **Misleading the community by advertising its own count** of submitted Public Comments to the BPDA (there is no official count). Submissions are **not intended as a polling opportunity** but as a way for citizens to share their descriptive, unique comments. Additionally, the Proponent's letter to City Officials regarding its assessment, which included an unenforceable "Good Neighbor Program," belittles the intelligence of the Officials and the Neighbors.



We urge you **TO STOP** the Development Project at 361 Belgrade in City of Boston, which:

- Does **NOT provide the PROMISED facility** to the STUDENTS,
- Blurs the explanation of its **LAND AGREEMENT**,
- Ignores **TRAFFIC and SAFETY** issues at the Site,
- Violates the 35 ft height **zoning restriction**, building higher than 50 ft (including HVAC),
- Violates the 35 parking **space restriction**, including 47 spaces for 67 adult drivers,
- Violates the **RULES of a DEED-RESTRICTED lot**, proposing a “multi-use courtyard,”
- Creates a **SAFETY ISSUE** - restricting emergency vehicle from access to the school - on the deed-restricted lot, and
- most importantly, betrays the trust of the voters of Ward 20.

I am writing this letter to you in support of Roslindale and West Roxbury residents fighting to stop a Charter School from being built at 361 Belgrade Avenue. Since you swore me onto the Boston City Council back in January I have heard from countless residents across the city regarding their sincere concerns that Boston is being overdeveloped, including in unique places like West Roxbury, which has a high percentage of homeowners and senior citizens. 361 Belgrade Ave, which is on the West Roxbury/Roslindale line, is a gateway to West Roxbury and a nearby rotary acts as the hub to a major, 4-lane road way (Centre Street) and a major, 4 lane parkway (West Roxbury Parkway) which navigates to Washington Street and it is already a confusing, congested and dangerous intersection. Building a Charter School at 361 Belgrade Ave would be detrimental to many residents as a result of the noise and a dramatic increase in traffic as there is currently no train scheduled to stop at Bellevue Station during school hours and the bus stops 400 feet from the school. Additionally, the BPDA proposal does not meet the standards that the proposer submitted in their Charter, as the submitted proposal is for about 550 students and 67 staff members, and is roughly 49,000 square feet. Because the size was dramatically reduced, the students will not get the benefits they were promised in what was supposed to be a state of the art school facility.

I want to make it abundantly clear to you and to the residents of the City Boston that I am not against Charter Schools. In fact, I even supported Charter Schools during the 1993-1994 Massachusetts House of Representatives Legislative Session when I served the City of Boston as a State Representative. However, I believe that Charter Schools must be located in the appropriate places in order to succeed, and the vast consensus among residents is that 361 Belgrade Ave is not a good location for Roxbury Prep.

I sponsored a resolution back in April calling for the Boston City Council to go on record in support of the residents of West Roxbury and Roslindale in opposing the proposal for a Charter School to be built at 361 Belgrade Ave, precisely because it is not the right place for a school. Citizens in Roslindale in West Roxbury feel totally ignored by the BPDA regarding their legitimate concerns about traffic. The safety of senior citizens and the other concerns I have outlined above are the reasons why I support this community 100%. Thank you for considering my perspective.
