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Introduction

Boston's economy continues to grow and recover following the Great Recession of 2007-2008. Amidst slow national recovery, Boston's labor market improves as the unemployment rate continues to decline and remains below the national average.¹ Boston's highly skilled labor force is an important attribute for company retention and further investment in the City. Following 2010, building permits and revenues for the city returned to prerecession levels, and business activity overall continues to increase in Boston across different industry sectors.²

Boston's leading research based industries including Health Care, Professional, Technological, and Scientific Services exhibited strong growth, complimenting Boston's highly skilled labor force. Currently, 54% of Boston's labor force has a bachelor's degree.³ While these big picture metrics provide an overall view of the City's economic health, the geographic distribution of jobs and business growth around Boston's neighborhoods tell the complete story.

Boston's unique neighborhoods offer companies different amenities: access to highly skilled employees, transit and other transportation access, and a variety of facility options. The facilities in Boston range from research laboratories in Allston and Brighton, to office space for Finance and Insurance industry clusters in Back Bay, to warehousing and distribution centers for logistics firms in East Boston. The following sections of this report look at each neighborhood's major industries, number of establishments, jobs, largest employers, and other defining neighborhood business characteristics. In addition, this report will provide some insight into the industry clusters and business patterns within Boston's neighborhoods.

Data and Methodology

The main data source for this report is the 2011 Zip Code Business Patterns (ZCBP), published by the U.S. Census Bureau. Boston neighborhood boundaries in this report are thus based on ZIP codes; a table listing the ZIP codes for each neighborhood, as well as a map of the neighborhood boundaries, can be found in the next section of this report. To create the employment maps shown for each neighborhood, InfoUSA data was used. While this dataset is not as complete or consistent as the ZCBP, it contains establishment street addresses. This allows us to provide a visual representation of the businesses' spatial distribution, but it should not be cross-referenced with the tabular data from the ZCBP.

For each zip code, ZCBP provides the total private sector employment, along with a matrix of the number of establishments, with industries on one axis and employment-size class on the other axis. ZCBP includes private sector payroll jobs only, excluding government and non-payroll (self-employed or working in family business) employment. Industries are defined by the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS). Size classes represent ranges of payroll employment count. The actual number of jobs in each industry or size class is not directly stated in the data due to disclosure restrictions—aimed at protecting individual businesses' privacy—but can be estimated from the number of establishments.


To estimate the actual number of jobs, we computed the mid-point of each employment-size class (i.e. for the employment-size class 100-249, the mid-point estimate of employees is 174.5). Then, the number of establishments in each range was multiplied by the employment mid-point (i.e. if a ZIP code had 3 health care establishments with 100-249 employees, we multiplied 3 by 174.5 to arrive at an employment estimate of 523.5 employees in health care). This procedure was performed for each industry row to obtain a provisional, unadjusted estimate of employment within a ZIP code across each industry.

Total employment is the only employment figure given at the ZIP code level, so our estimates for each industry had to add up to this total. Because the sum of these mid-point estimates does not match the total actual employment figure for the whole ZIP code given by the ZCBP (the mid-point estimates tend to overestimate actual employment), the mid-point estimates had to be adjusted. In ZIP codes with no establishments with 1,000+ employees, we simply calculated an adjustment factor by taking the actual total employment figure and dividing it by the sum of the mid-point estimates. We then applied that adjustment factor to all mid-point estimates, multiplying the estimate by the adjustment factor. This resulted in a table where the sum of adjusted mid-point estimates by industry equaled the actual total employment given in the ZCBP.

The mid-point method could not be used for establishments in the largest, open ended, size class (1,000+ employees). Employment for these establishments was determined by identifying each individual establishment and actual employment where possible, utilizing the BRA's 2013 report "The Largest Employers in the City of Boston." It was not possible to match up all large establishments in the ZCBP with known establishments. For neighborhoods that had unidentified largest employers, another method of estimation was necessary. First, we assumed that the mid-point estimates of the employment-size classes were overestimating total employment. Second, we multiplied these mid-point estimates by 0.87 because this was the average margin of error for neighborhoods where the largest employers were identified. Next, total employment was subtracted from the adjusted mid-point estimates, representing total employment for the 1,000+ establishments.

Boston's Private Sector Employment and Establishments

For the purposes of this report, Boston private sector employment is divided into ten industry sectors⁴. The three largest sectors by share of employment are Health Care and Social Assistance, Professional and Business Services and Information, and Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate (F.I.R.E). Together they comprise over sixty percent of all employment in Boston. The F.I.R.E. and Health Care and Social Assistance sectors in particular outperform national employment data significantly in terms of share of employment.

Boston's industry sectors in terms of employment size (2011) and their growth rates (2002 through 2011) are as follows:

- **Health Care and Social Assistance** This is the largest sector in Boston, accounting for over a quarter of the city's total employment in 2011. It was one of the few sectors to see an increase in employment from 2002 to 2011, growing by 32.6%. Its location quotient is 1.63, showing it accounts for a larger share of employment in Boston than it does nationally.
- **Professional and Business Services and Information** the second largest sector in Boston by share of employment, with 11,602 employees on its payroll in 2011. Despite a 13.9% drop in employment share from 2002 to 2011, it still comprises over twenty percent of total employment in Boston.
- **Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate-** the third largest sector in Boston, accounting for 18.9% of total employment in the city. It saw a 12.0% decline from 2002, but is the strongest sector when compared to national employment data (LQ of 2.75).
- Leisure and Hospitality generated 58,666 jobs in 2011, an almost 12% increase from 2002. The sector's location quotient showed it almost on par with national data (LQ of 0.91).
- Other This measures the aggregate of the remaining industries, most of which reside in personal service firms. The "other" category accounted for 19,541 jobs in 2011, showing a 22.7% decline from 2002. ⁵

- Retail Trade- Retail trade showed a slight decline from 2002, falling 2.1% to 27,182 jobs in 2011. However, its share of total employment in Boston (5.1%) remained unchanged.
- Wholesale Trade and Transportation Employment in this sector contracted 17.3% from 2002 and its share of total employment is half of the national average.
- **Utilities and Construction** Utilities and Construction saw a sharp drop in employment (-40.1%) from 2002, but accounted for only 1.8% of total employment in the city. Some of these large Construction job losses are due in part to the completion of the Central Artery Tunnel Project (Big Dig) and the decline of the housing market following the Great Recession.
- Educational Services Educational Services accounts for 7.1% of all employment in Boston. It was one of the few sectors to see an increase in employment from 2002, growing by 19.3% and accounts for a larger share of employment in Boston than the nation (LQ 2.37).
- Manufacturing Manufacturing saw the steepest decline in employment, falling 40.9% from 2002 to 2011, and is well below the national average concentration for this industry (LQ of 0.16).


Boston's economic concentration, measured by its industry's Location Quotient (LQ), shows that the city's strengths are mainly in the areas of F.I.R.E (2.75), Educational Services (2.37), and Health Care and Social Assistance (1.63) - Table 1. The LQ shows the degree of concentration of industry-economic specialization and compares the city industry concentration (employment in this industry as a percentage of the total jobs in Boston) to the national average concentration for this industry. The sectors with an LQ greater than 1 indicate a higher industry concentration in Boston than the nation.

Spatial Distribution of Boston's Employers and Employment




Employment Size and Growth

The size of Boston's leading sectors vary- from the "big three" of Health Care and Social Assistance, Professional and Business Services and Information, and Finance, Insurance and Real Estate to the smaller sectors that include Utilities and Construction and Manufacturing. In addition, growth rates vary among sectors. For example, between 2002 and 2011, the fastest growing industries in terms of employment were Health Care and Social Assistance, Leisure and Hospitality and Educational Services. The respective shares of total employment in Boston, however, vary greatly among these three sectors (as shown by the relative sizes of the bubbles in figure 1).

The period between 2002 and 2011 saw a decline in employment across most industries, with only three sectors showing expansion.





The majority of firms in Boston are small employers, with almost half (47.9%) of establishments listed as having 1-4 workers. Utilities and Construction and Professional, Business Services and Information have the highest proportion of small employers, with those employing 1-4 workers accounting for more than half of all establishments in those sectors.

Educational Services has the largest percentage of establishments with 100 or more employees, with colleges accounting for most of that group. Health Care and Social Assistance has the second largest percentage of large employers, with firms employing 100 or more workers, comprising 7.8% of total establishments in the sector.

As expected, the largest firms generate the majority of jobs in Boston. Despite comprising the smallest share of total establishments in Boston, employers with 100 or more workers account for well over half (66.7%) of all employment in the city. This is most apparent in the Health Care and Social Assistance, Educational Services, and F.I.R.E sectors, where large employers generate 87.4%, 88.4%, and 76.8% of all employment within those sectors, respectively. The largest private employers in Boston are listed in the table below.




Citywide and Neighborhood Business Patterns


The following maps illustrate the location of establishments by industry and number of employees. The maps demonstrate how the major industries are spread across Boston's neighborhoods and where industry clusters have formed. Industries like Health Care and Social Assistance are more uniformly distributed across the city of Boston, while Educational Services is the most prominent in the central Boston, Fenway, and Kenmore neighborhoods. Following these citywide establishment maps is a discussion of each neighborhood's business patterns and detailed neighborhood maps.


























Allston/Brighton

Allston/Brighton is home to 1,234 establishments, with the largest number of them in Professional, Business Services, and Information (229/18.6%), Leisure and Hospitality (226/18.3%), and Retail Trade (179/14.5%). It has 24,088 jobs, which is 4.5% of all private jobs in Boston. The largest sector in terms of employment is Health Care and Social Assistance (5,654/23.5%), followed by Professional, Business Services, and Information (5,441/22.6%) and Leisure and Hospitality (2,830/11.7%).

Allston/Brighton has six establishments that employ 500 people or more, accounting for 7,989 jobs, or 33.2%, of employment in the neighborhood.

Back Bay/Beacon Hill

Back Bay/Beacon Hill is home to 3,322 establishments, with the largest number of them in Professional, Business Services, and Information (1,014/30.5%), Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate (602/18.1%), and Retail Trade (503/15.1%). It has 92,754 jobs, which is 17.3% of all private jobs in Boston. The largest sector in terms of employment is Professional, Business Services, and Information (31,846/34.3%), followed by Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate (22,812/24.6%) and Leisure and Hospitality (15,347/16.5%).

Back Bay/Beacon Hill has 27 establishments that employ 500 people or more, accounting for 30,040 jobs, or 32.4%, of employment in the neighborhood.







Back Bay/Beacon Hill Establishments by Size and Industry Sector



Central Boston

Central Boston is home to 4,701 establishments, with the largest number of them in Professional, Business Services, and Information (1,682/35.8%), Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate (1,163/24.7%), and Leisure and Hospitality (563/12.0%). It has 170,481 jobs, which is 31.7% of all private jobs in Boston. The largest sector in terms of employment is Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate (58,200/34.1%), followed by Professional, Business Services, and Information (47,825/28.1%) and Health Care and Social Assistance (35,712/20.9%).

Central Boston has 39 establishments that employ 500 people or more, accounting for 84,203 jobs, or 49.4%, of employment in the neighborhood.

Charlestown

Charlestown is home to 429 establishments, with the largest number of them in Professional, Business Services, and Information (125/29.1%), Other (57/13.3%), and Leisure and Hospitality (51/11.9%). The vast majority of "Other" establishments fall under NAICS code 81, which is most represented here by parking services, religious organizations, and dry cleaners. The neighborhood has 7,760 jobs, which is 1.4% of all private jobs in Boston. The largest sector in terms of employment is Professional, Business Services, and Information (2,446/31.5%), followed by Health Care and Social Assistance (1,412/18.2%) and Wholesale Trade, Transportation and Warehousing (1,173/15.1%).

Charlestown has one establishment that employs 500 people or more, accounting for 671 jobs, or 8.6%, of employment in the neighborhood.


South End Establishments by Size and Industry Sector

West Roxbury

West Roxbury is home to 473 establishments, with the largest number of them in Professional, Business Services, and Information (83/17.5%), Other (80/16.9%), and Health Care and Social Assistance (73/15.4%). The vast majority of "Other" establishments fall under NAICS code 81, which is most represented here by religious organizations, beauty and nail salons, and automotive services. The neighborhood has 7,238 jobs, which is 1.3% of all private jobs in Boston. The largest sector in terms of employment is Health Care and Social Assistance (2,264/31.3%), followed by Retail Trade (1,649/22.8%) and Leisure and Hospitality (909/12.6%).

West Roxbury has two establishments that employ 500 people or more, accounting for 1,678 jobs, or 23.2%, of employment in the neighborhood.
