

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#### Introduction

This *Historical Boston in Context* document compares how Boston, Boston's neighborhoods, Massachusetts, and the United States changed demographically between 1950 and 2015. It uses data from the United States Census Bureau's Decennial Censuses and American Community Surveys.


The choice of 1950 is not arbitrary. In 1950, Boston's population reached a peak it never reached before or after, at 801,444 residents. The intervening years between 1950 and the present were turbulent, with a period of population decline until 1980, followed by a growing population in the last three and a half decades. In the same time period, Boston was impacted by important national trends. These include rapidly increasing levels of educational attainment, a growing foreign-born population, more women in the labor force, and growth in the non-white population. In some other ways, though, Boston resisted national trends. While the nation as a whole has gotten progressively older, Boston has witnessed enormous growth in its population between ages 20 and 34.

The data presented here compare across years as consistently as possible. In some years, the Census data do not allow for certain variables, and those cases are noted throughout. In each year, the contemporary 2010 Census Tract boundaries are used to calculate consistent neighborhood values. See the methodology section at the end of this report for more information about these calculations.

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### **Boston's Neighborhoods**

- Boston is a city defined by the unique character of its many neighborhoods. The BPDA counts 26 neighborhoods within the city's 48.4 square mile footprint.
- Unfortunately, the neighborhood boundaries recognized by the BPDA do not align neatly with Census Tract boundaries.
- The traditional boundaries, delineated in red on the adjacent map, are based on a combination of Census Tracts, Zip Codes, and Zoning Districts. For the purposes of this report, however, data is presented based on the 23 color-coded groups of 2010 Census Tracts that correspond as closely as possible to neighborhood boundaries.
- In most cases, the differences between the Census Tractbased boundaries and the traditional boundaries are minor. However, we are not able to present data separately for Chinatown and the Leather District, which are included with Downtown in this report, or Bay Village, which is included with the South End.







To create neighborhood-level data, we use U.S. Census Tracts to define neighborhood boundaries. The Census Bureau, however, has changed the boundaries of its Census Tracts across the decades. We use the most recent map of Census Tracts (from the 2010 Census), then where necessary, we interpolate data from earlier years' Census Tracts to conform to the tracts from 2010. When Census Tracts change, we use that year's population by Census Block, the smallest geographic unit available in the Census, to create population weights that are used to apportion populations from earlier years to 2010 Census Tracts. In cases where Census Blocks overlap the boundaries of 2010 Census Tracts, the share of block land area on either side of the 2010 tract boundary is incorporated into the weights. In earlier years, when Census Block boundaries are not available, we use a modified method that employs 1990 Census Block geography, the oldest year available. The next three pages describe these calculations in more depth. Fortunately, most of the Census Tract boundary changes that occur take place within the broader neighborhoods we study, not between them. As a result, the approximation methods described on the following pages have relatively little impact on the final results. The methods used here are similar to those used in the commercially available Neighborhood Change Database (NCDB), produced by the Urban Institute and Geolytics, and the public use Longitudinal Tract Database (LTDB) produced by the American Communities Project. Because our geographic scope is limited to Boston, we are able to extend our crosswalk back over a longer time period than either of these sources, and to cover a larger set of variables than is available from the NCDB. Our method also uses block-level population weighting for all years, whereas the LTDB uses area-based weighting for earlier years. Creation of our crosswalk was greatly aided by the availability of historic tract and block-level GIS shapefiles from the National Historical Geographic Information System (NHGIS) at the Minnesota Population Center.



- Our crosswalk method takes the boundaries in red (2000 tract boundaries), and converts them into the boundaries represented by teal and light blue (2010 tract boundaries). Depicted here is the splitting of a 2000 Census Tract 805 in Roxbury into 2010 Census Tracts 804.01 and 805.
- The dotted line boundaries (2000 block boundaries) help create the weights needed to break 2000 Tracts, when necessary, into a 2010 Tract approximation.
- In this example, these diagonally shaded 2000 Blocks are used to determine how much of the population in their 2000 Census Tract should be assigned to the light blue 2010 Census Tract. Here, the population in the shaded blocks makes up 37.2% of the year 2000 population of the tract. The remaining 62.8% percent belongs to the teal tract.
- These weights are applied to the population of each subgroup (age, race, educational attainment) we study. This implicitly assumes that each subgroup is distributed throughout the 2000 tract in proportion to the overall population. This is an imperfect assumption, but allows us to develop estimates for attributes where block-level data is not available.



- Sometimes, a year 2000 Census Block itself is divided between two or more year 2010 Census Tracts, complicating the use of its population as a weight in assigning 2000 population.
- This is most often the case in areas with parks and open space, because the 2010 Census categorized these areas differently than in prior years.
- The example at left is the area around the Arnold Arboretum in Jamaica Plain and Roslindale. In 2000, we can see that one block (the one highlighted by the light blue boundary) spans an area that in 2010 was part of three different Census tracts: red on the left, purple in the middle, and blue to the right.
- To determine the necessary ratio to assign to the appropriate 2010 tracts, proportions of land area are used instead of block-based populations, because population information is not available below the Census Block level.
- Fortunately most of the cases of split blocks deal with sparsely populated areas such as parks, so the assumptions have limited consequences for our neighborhood estimates.

For years prior to 1990, shapefiles of Census Block-level data are not available. When Census Tract boundaries change in an earlier year, we follow a three step procedure to create weights to assign populations to 2010 Census Tracts. Using 1970 as an example:

- 1) We overlay the 1990 Census Block map on the 1970 Census Tract map. In the absence of information on the layout of the 1970 population within tracts, we assume it follows the shape of the 1990 population. This assumption is plausible, since population clusters along the street grid of the city, and with a few notable exceptions, the street grid of Boston kept the same shape throughout the period. In places where there were radical changes to the street grid, or where large multi-family housing development radically altered the balance of population within narrow geographies, our method may lead to inaccuracies.
- 2) Following this assumption, when 1970 tract boundaries overlap 1990 tract boundaries, we can calculate the share of the 1970 population of a 1970 tract that falls on either side of the 1990 boundary by taking the sum of the 1990 population of the 1990 Census Blocks that overlap the 1970 tract that fall on one side of the 1990 boundary over the total 1990 population of all 1990 blocks that overlap the 1970 tract. This is comparable to the methods we described for adjusting 2000 data to 2010 boundaries, except here we weight by 1990 population density (weighting by population density in the later year) instead of weighting by the population density in the earlier year. While weighting by earlier year density is preferable, in the absence of block-level data in the earlier year, we think the later year weighting is the best method available.
- 3) Having created a crosswalk from 1970 Census Tracts to 1990 Census Tracts, we can then use the 1990 Census Tract to 2010 Census Tract crosswalk developed through the methods described on the prior pages to calculate weights that can be used to crosswalk the 1970 data to the 2010 Census Tracts.

While there were a fair number of tract boundary changes over the full time period we study, the vast majority of these boundary changes occur within the larger neighborhood geographies, rather than between them. In these cases, the boundary changes do not affect the numbers shown in this report, as both portions of the divided tract are aggregated into the same neighborhood.
