AGREEMENT WITH BOSTON WATERBOAT MARINA, INC. FOR THE USE OF BOSTON REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OWNED WATER

SHEET ON LONG WHARF

SUMMARY: This Memorandum requests that the Director be authorized to enter into a

License Agreement with Boston Waterboat Marina, Inc. for the exclusive use of approximately 4,125 square feet of additional water sheet adjacent

to Waterboat Marina located on Long Wharf.

## **BACKGROUND**

Boston Waterboat Marina, Inc. ("BWM") currently licenses 187,120 square feet of water sheet and 250 square feet of land from the Boston Redevelopment Authority ("BRA") at Long Wharf where they operate the Waterboat Marina. Citing seasonal demand to accommodate additional vessels, BWM has requested the use of approximately 4,125 square feet of additional BRA owned water sheet located adjacent to the eastern most portion of their licensed premises as set forth on the attached plan.

## PROPOSAL AND RECOMMENDATION

The term of the License will be from July 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013. BWM accepts the water sheet in its "as-is" condition.

## FISCAL IMPACTS

The license fee for the use of the water sheet will be Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred ad Fifty Dollars \$13,250.
