

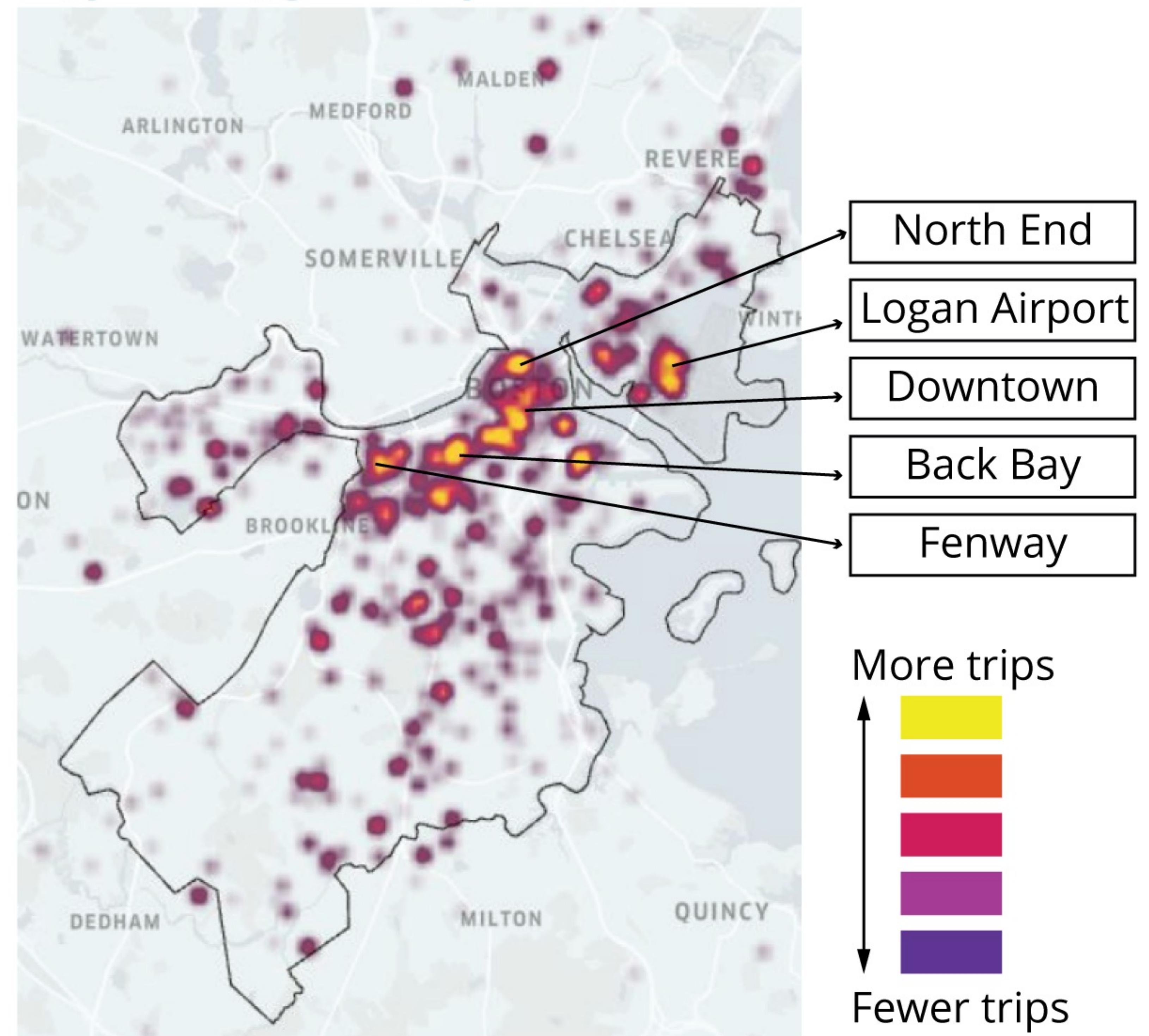
Boston's Nighttime Economy

Highlights

- ~46,000 workers (7.1%) work night shifts
- Leisure and hospitality industries have the highest share of night shift workers (13.5%)
- Top industries with the largest number of night shift workers:
 - Hospitals (7,300+)
 - Restaurants and Bars (6,200+)
 - Schools and Colleges (4,400+)

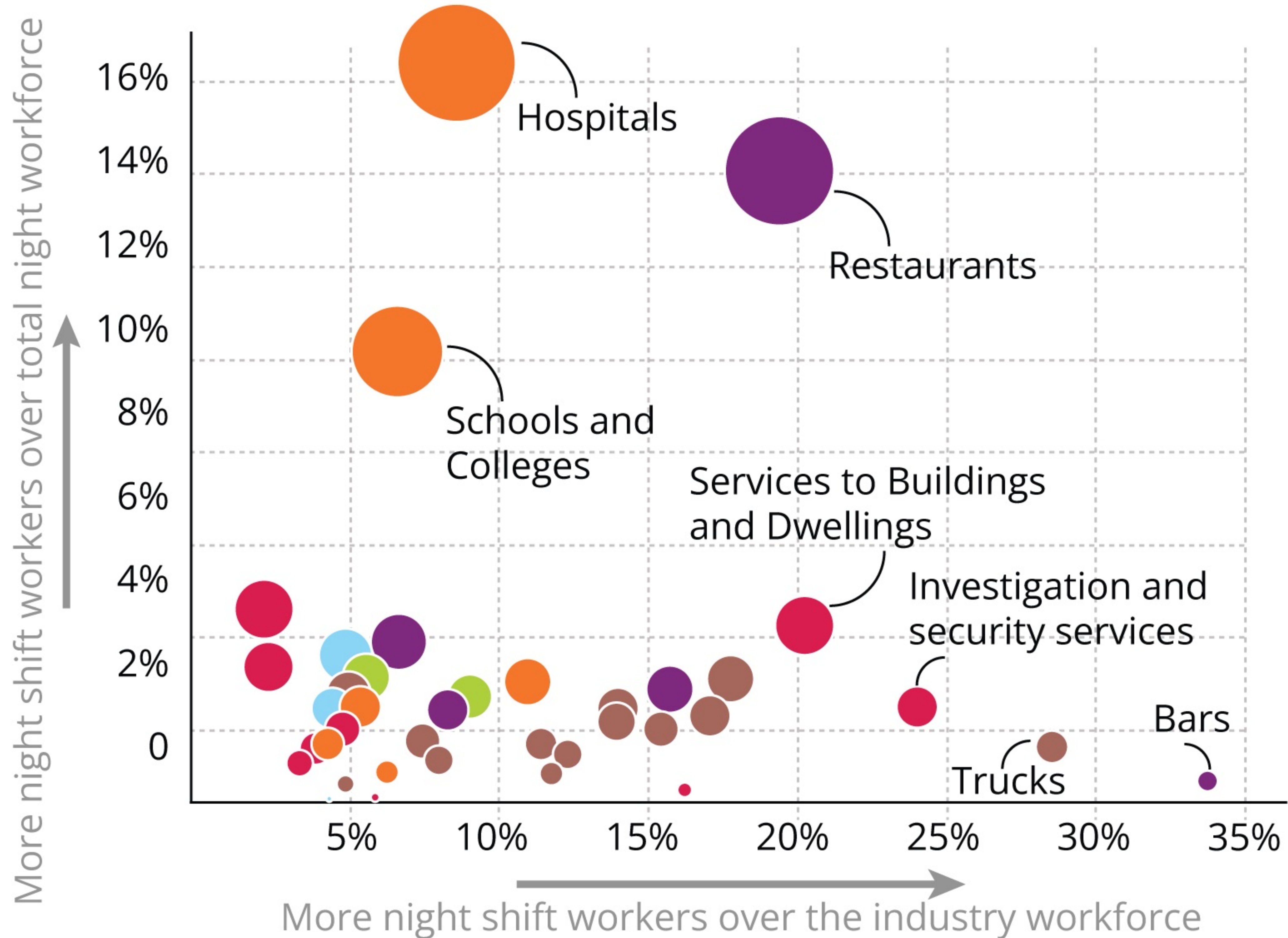
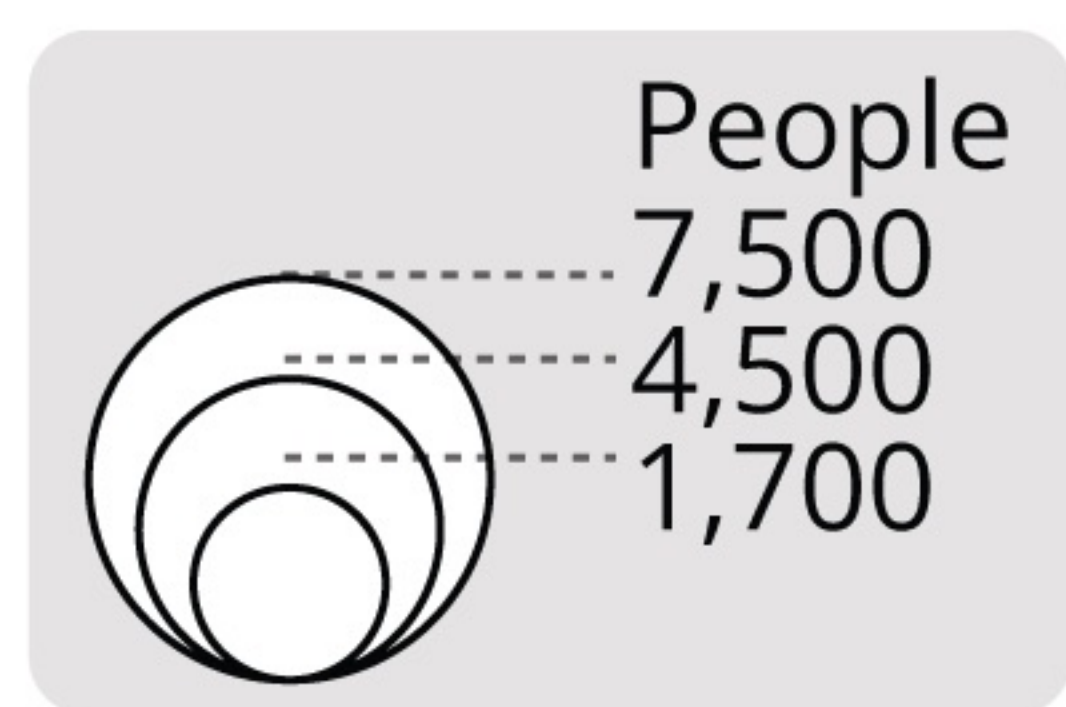
Boston Nighttime Movement

Trips starting from 9pm to 1am

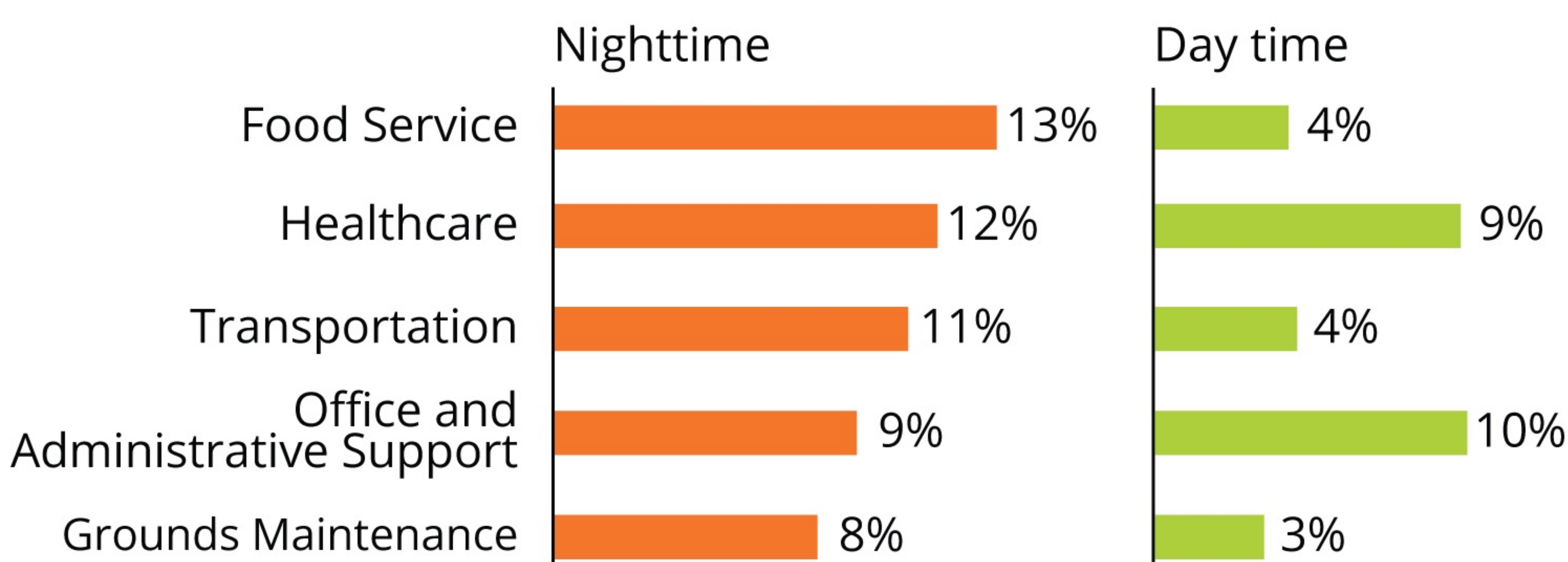


Nighttime Industries
