Ancestry Characteristics:


- The top 10 ancestries in Boston are: Irish, Italian, West Indian, English, German, Subsaharan African, U.S. or American, Polish, French, and Russian.
- The top 10 ancestries in Boston remained the same in 1990 and 2000, though their rankings have changed.
- Irish still leads the list of ancestries in Boston by a 2:1 margin over Italian, though the number with Irish ancestry has dropped by more than 27% and the number with Italian ancestry has dropped almost 19%.
- Among the top 10, West Indian and Subsaharan African ancestries both grew by over 11,000, and the U.S. or American category increased by over 8,000; whereas all other ancestries decreased in number.
- West Indian ancestry jumped from 5th place in 1990 to 3rd in 2000, displacing English which dropped to 4th.
- Subsaharan African jumped from 10th place in 1990 to 6th in 2000; the U.S. or American category moved from 9th place to 7th.




