
Boston's Immigration, Foreign Born Population and Language Spoken 1990-2000 trends2000




#### Trends in Immigration and Language Spoken at Home:

Over 25% of Boston's population is foreign born today, up from 20% in 1990.

- Almost half of the foreign born residents (48.5%) entered the U.S. in the past 10 years; they represent 12.5% of the residents of Boston.
- Nearly half of the foreign born residents (47.6%) came from Latin America, followed by Asia (24%), Europe (17.5%), and Africa (9%).

One in ten residents of the city is a naturalized citizen, up from one in fourteen ten years ago.

- About 16% of the residents are not citizens, up from about 13% in 1990.
- Today, one-third of Boston's residents speak a language other than English, up from 25.6% in 1990; and over 16% do not speak English very well compared to 13% in 1990.
  - Almost 14% of the residents speak Spanish, compared to less than 10% ten years ago; and over 6% speak an Asian language, up from a little more than 4% in 1990.
  - About half of those who speak Spanish do not speak English very well; while about two-thirds of those who speak an Asian language do not speak English very well.
- Almost 30% of the people in Boston did not live here in 1995; about the same percentage as ten years previously.
  - On the other hand, nearly half of the residents of the city lived in the same house five years before the 2000 census.
  - Less than half of the people in the city (47.4%) were born in Massachusetts compared to more than 51% in 1990.



## 2. REGION OF BIRTH OF FOREIGN BORN








