

Site Locus Map






Existing Conditions Site Plan




Proposed Conditions Site Plan


PROJECT SITE BOUNDARY

Study possibilities to increase Public Open Space:

Make Lansdowne Street sidewalk as generous as possible

Maximize gathering space at entrance at the point

Building Envelope:

Study architectural transition between the Theater House sidewall and existing Fenway Garage.

April 16, 2019: Work Session #2

Comments:

Streetscape:

Simplify materials and patterns of landscape design

Maximize effective width of sidewalks near entrance

Keep Lansdowne Street sidewalk unencumbered by furnishings and/or trees

Consider furnishings and trees at Ipswich Street beyond main entrance

Reduce density of bollards as possible

Building Envelope:

Continue study of transition between Theater House sidewall and existing Fenway Garage

Consider retaining entire Fenway Garage facade


Develop architecture of Theater House wall to be compatible with, but not reliant on signage elements.











Section D - Intersection of Lansdowne and Ipswich Streets






Sidewalk Section at Theater Entry




