



PHASE I ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION AND SITE PREPARATION FERDINAND/GUSCOTT BUILDING

WELCOME (BRA Staff)

- Paul Osborn of the BRA introduced members of the Jacobs technical team and provided an overview of the project purpose and scope.
- Mr. Osborn stressed the need for the BRA and community to work in partnership to put the site back into full use, while preserving the historic features of the buildings.
- Stephen Healy of the BRA introduced the Jacobs technical team.

PROJECT OVERVIEW (Jacobs Technical Team)

- Joseph Anthony of Jacobs provided an overview of the environmental inventory; geotechnical investigation; and structural inspection.
- Mr. Anthony indicated that key project goals include the following:
 - Creating a clean and safe site;
 - Historic Preservation
 - o Environmental Remediation
- Mr. Anthony pointed out that environmental investigations indicate the presence of lead-based paint and asbestos in both buildings. All environmental remediation will be performed in accordance with the guidelines and requirements of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection.
- Joseph Anthony indicated that based on structural inspections of the Guscott Building it
 has been determined that moisture has damaged the building due to long-term exposure
 to weather conditions.
- Site soil borings were conducted to determine the depth of bed rock.

- Virginia Adams of PAL, architectural historian, provided an overview of the façade inspection. She indicated that the façade inspection was conducted by PAL and Building Conservation Associates for the purpose of identifying materials and conditions so that a plan can be designed to preserve the historic façade. The inspection revealed some façade deterioration that can be stabilized.
- Ms. Adams provided an overview of the Article 85 Demolition Delay application that was submitted to the Boston Landmarks Commission; and the Project Notification Form that was submitted to the Massachusetts Historic Commission. Ms. Adams pointed out that the BLC Hearing will be held on August 28 at 6:30 pm in the BRA Board Room, 9th Floor, Boston City Hall.
- Donald Stull of Stull & Lee Architects presented the various re-development alternatives
 that were explored for the Guscott Building between 1988 to the present. Mr. Stull
 pointed out that building deterioration, seismic design constraints, and space usage
 constraints limited the building's re-development potential.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- Joseph Anthony pointed out that if demolition is approved, changes to pedestrian patterns will be necessary to keep pedestrians clear of the site during this process. He pointed out that a new pedestrian crossing will be established on Warren Street near Dudley Station and the current pedestrian crossing at Washington Street will continue to be used.
- Mr. Anthony pointed out that in order to keep the trucks hauling debris from creating traffic disruptions, a reverse traffic flow for these trucks will be created via Washington Street with the assistance of police officers to control traffic. An estimated ten trucks a day will access and egress the site via Washington Street. Due to the grade differential at Warren Street, trucks will not be able to use this end of the site.

CONSTRUCTION FENCE AND ART WORK

Stephen Healy of the BRA presented the plan for the construction fence and art work.
 Mr. Healy indicated that the construction fencing will be erected for safety reasons and historic Dudley Square photos will be erected on the fence using digitized versions of the photos.

NEXT STEPS

- Paul Osborn of the BRA indicated that the next important step in the process is to get BLC and MHC approval of the demolition request. Mr. Osborn stressed the importance of community support through letters of support and speaking on behalf of the project at the August 28 BLC Hearing so that the project can continue to advance to the redevelopment phase.
- Mr. Osborn pointed out that during demolition, a "Community Information Center" will be located onsite at the construction trailer to address any community questions and concerns. Mr. Osborn also pointed out that efforts to hire local workers and businesses will be conducted.
- Mr. Osborn indicated that review of the traffic management plan by the Boston
 Transportation Department must be completed and that once Phase I is completed the

BRA will immediately begin the process of preparing a Phase II Request For Proposals (RFP) to select a design team followed by the issuance of a RFP to select a contractor.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Kenneth Guscott, former owner of the Guscott Building, indicated that his company purchased the building in an effort to help restore Dudley Square, but a major challenge was attracting office workers. He stressed that the BRA is moving in the right direction with the demolition process and by initiating dialogue with the community.
- How long will the demolition process last? The projected schedule for environmental remediation and demolition is six months after receipt of BLC and MHC approvals.
- Will there be continuing meetings with the community during the process, or will the "Community Information Center" be provided in lieu of community meetings? A community member suggested monthly meetings and another suggested posting project updates on the BRA website to supplement community meetings. The BRA indicated they will continue to meet with the community on a regular basis.
- Kenneth Guscott stressed the importance of making sure that minority-owned subcontractors get a fair shot at inclusion in the project. He pointed out that the BRA should make sure they have language in the bid documents to ensure that this happens, and that the BRA should hire a minority company to do the outreach to increase minority business participation. Paul Osborn of the BRA indicated that related language is included in their contracts; and suggested that business and worker names be forwarded to the agency.
- What measures will be taken during environmental remediation to protect the public? The BRA and Jacobs will conduct environmental remediation in accordance with the requirements of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection. Also, an environmental engineer will be on site throughout the process.
- What historic preservations alternatives are being explored? The BRA is looking to
 preserve the Ferdinand building. More specific alternatives will be discussed with the
 BLC and the MHC during the review process and shared with the community at the next
 meeting.
- What specifics will be presented to the BLC? The specifics of the demolition delay request will be presented for a discussion about whether there should be a 90-day demolition delay for the Guscott Building based on historic significance. A separate Article 85 application will be prepared for the Ferdinand Building.
- Kenneth Guscott stressed the importance of moving the project forward and getting BLC and MHC approval after over 20 years of trying to get this site redeveloped.
- Fred Fairfield, Dudley Business/Property Owner and Board Chairman of Dudley Main Streets indicated he is glad the BRA is moving forward to re-develop the site and congratulated the BRA for initiating dialogue with the community early in the process.
- Sarah Kelly of the Boston Preservation Alliance asked how a 90-day delay would impact the project. The BRA responded that a 90-day delay will put the project off track until the spring.

- Joyce Stanley, Executive Director of Dudley Main Streets asked if abutters had been contacted about site impacts. Paul Osborn and Stephan Healy indicated that all abutters have been notified and the BRA has requested an opportunity to walk through their buildings and take photos and schedule the installation of vibration monitoring equipment on the adjacent Curtis and Waterman buildings on Washington Street. However, Mr. Osborn pointed out it has been difficult getting a response from abutters. Joyce Stanley indicated that she can help to move this process along.
- Some attendees asked whether public open space/parks will be included in the Phase II
 design. The BRA indicated that specific uses will be more clearly defined during the
 design phase.
- Joyce Stanley indicated that Dudley Main Streets has already expressed to Mayor Menino their preference that the new design include ground-floor retail with offices above.
- How long will it take to get Phase II underway? The BRA indicated it will take time to get the project to the redevelopment phase. However, they pointed out that the agency and the Mayor's office are committed to getting the project done. The approximate projection for issuance of the RFP for a project design team is this fall. Dana Whiteside of the BRA indicated that as information becomes available, the agency can prepare a Phase II time line for the community.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:15PM.







