- Answer: The web page access to this file had been temporarily interrupted. The problem has been resolved. To ensure access to these files,

copies in .pdf and .dwg format have been emailed to all shortlisted firms.

- Question 4: Is the list available for the 27 firms that responded for the Dudley Square Municipal Building? Also, is the designer selection committee list available?
- Answer: Yes. Answer: Yes.

- Question 8: Is it possible to propose now the demolition of the existing buildings on Washington street, Number 2304-2308 and Number 2328 in ten years (or less) time?
- Answer: It is not the City's intent to limit or constrain teams from presenting their qualifications and concepts in the manner best suited to each team. The RFQ encourages design teams to consider the context of the site, the surrounding neighborhood and potential changes in the neighborhood over time. Teams are reminded, however, that the objective of this designer selection process is to have teams demonstrate their overall qualifications to provide design services for the proposed facility on the site that exists today.
- Question 9: Is it possible to suggest a re-designed bus station?
- Answer: Similar to question #8 above, the City does not want to limit teams from demonstrating their qualifications in the manner they choose. Again, however, the goal of this RFQ process is to determine the team that can best design the Dudley Square Municipal Office Facility on the designated site with existing conditions and budget.
- Question 10: Is a comprehensive Traffic and Loading/Unloading design needed at this time?
- Answer: The City has no current opinion on this matter. It is up to individual teams to determine what is needed to convey their qualifications for this project.
- Question 11: Do we need a cost estimate of our proposed design strategies?
- Answer: The RFQ does not specify that a cost estimate is required at this time. Teams are reminded that the advertised construction range for this facility is \$65,000,000 to \$90,000,000. It is expected that the design concepts will reflect that range.
- Question 12: Is the façade the most important piece of the Ferdinand Building, or the building in its entirety?
