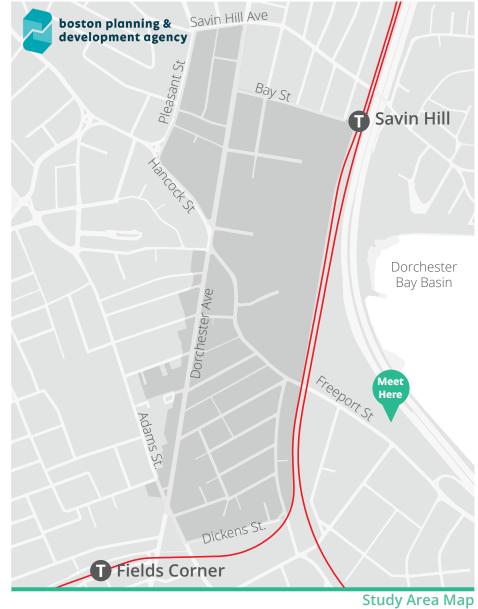
Interpretation and translated materials will be provided in Vietnamese and Cape Verdean Creole languages.

Refreshments will be provided.

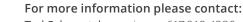
