

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) hereby provides initial notice of its proposal to provide Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program funding for an action located in a floodplain. Funding would be provided through the Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) to the City of Boston, for the Resilient Fort Point Channel Infrastructure Project.

The proposed action is located along the eastern shoreline of Fort Point Channel, with the closest street being Binford Street in Boston, MA 02210. The goal of the project is to implement resilient flood protection infrastructure along a portion of Fort Point Channel to reduce coastal flood risks to Fort Point, South Boston, and adjacent neighborhoods. The project proposes approximately 2,300 linear feet of mixed berm and floodwall mitigation features along the eastern shoreline of the channel.

The project is within a mapped special flood hazard area (100-year floodplain and 500-year floodplain). The project area is currently subject to occasional flooding, which is anticipated to increase as sea levels rise.

FEMA is working with the project proponent to prepare an environmental assessment for the project. Map requests and comments about this project and potential floodplain impacts are encouraged to be submitted within 15 days of the date of this publication to:
