PUBLIC HEARING

2. Chairman Nichols opened the hearing at 9:21 AM regarding Map Amendment Application No. 795 and a petition for approval of the First Amendment to the Boston University Charles River Campus 2024-2026 Institutional Master Plan.

The following offered testimony on the amendments:

Tyler Ross, Sr. Project Manager, Planning Department Gregg Snyder, Campus Planning – BU Pam Beale, Chair BU Task Force Dolores Boogdanian, Pres. Audubon Circle Neighborhood Association

Tyler Ross presented the proposed Amendment to the Commission. The University is adding 13 Buswell Street to its portfolio. No planned changes are being made to the building.

Gregg Snyder stated that if approved, 13 Buswell will apply for a dormitory license, with a hopeful opening in the Fall of 2025.

Pam Beale spoke in favor of the proposed amendment.

Dolores Boogdanian spoke in opposition in principle. She is opposed to the acquisition of the property by BU as a dormitory and a loss of residential units and taxable property.

Chairman Nichols acknowledged the receipt of Audubon Circle's letter submitted to the Commission.

Mr. Snyder appreciated the attendance of both Pam Beale and Dolores Boogdanian for taking the time to appear today.

The hearing closed at 9:30 AM, BZC entered the Business Meeting.
