



In 2020, Hawaii, California, and Washington, had the largest **APIA** populations. **Massachusetts** ranked 27th.




### Boston has higher shares of Chinese, Asian Indian, Vietnamese, and Korean populations than the state or the nation

Shares of APIA Populations, 2023 (US and Massachusetts), 2024 (Boston)




### Multiracial APIA, Asian Indians, and Chinese are the fastest growing APIA groups in Boston

APIA Population Change, 2010 to 2024




### The APIA population is predominantly foreign born and its growth has depended on US immigration policy

Foreign born shares of APIA populations, 2023 (US and Massachusetts), 2024 (Boston)




### College students make up almost a third of Boston's APIA population, a higher share than in Massachusetts and the country

Boston, Quincy, Lowell, Cambridge, and Malden were the Massachusetts cities with the largest APIA populations in 2020






### The APIA population of Boston is more than 5 times larger than it was in 1980, reaching 96,636 - 13.6% of Boston's population - in 2024

Top 10 APIA Populations in Boston by Race/Origin, 2024






### APIA populations in Boston, especially Chinese and Asian Indians, are likely to be foreign born

Foreign born APIA Population Share by Citizenship Status, 2024




### Vietnamese in Boston have the highest median age (38) while multiracial APIA are the youngest (24)

APIA Populations in Boston by Median Age, 2024




#### ~25% of APIA residents speak only English at home, but Chinese and Vietnamese are the most common Asian languages spoken at home

Top Languages Spoken by Boston APIA Populations at Home, 2024




### Close to half of Vietnamese and Chinese residents self-identify as speaking English "less than very well"

APIA Population in Boston by Share with Limited English Speaking Proficiency, age 5+, 2024




### Over 60% of Asian Indian and Chinese young adults in Boston are enrolled in college or university

APIA Populations in Boston by Shares Enrolled in College or University, age 18-29, 2024




### ~30% of APIA householders in Boston are homeowners, a similar rate to city overall

Share of APIA Householders who are owners of their residence, 2024




#### Many APIA renting households are rent cost burdened

Share of APIA Renter Households Paying More than 35% of their Income on Rent, 2024




#### APIA residents are more likely to live in large buildings

Share of APIA Family Households in Boston, 2024






### Chinese, Asian Indians, and Vietnamese are the three largest APIA populations working in Suffolk County

Top 10 APIA Populations in Suffolk County's Labor Force, 2023




### ~70% of APIA workers in Suffolk County have Bachelor's, graduate, or professional degrees

APIA workers with at least a college degree aged 25 and older, 2023




## The ~66,000 APIA workers in Suffolk County are overrepresented in computer engineering, healthcare, education and food service

APIA workers by occupation, 2023




### Most APIA workers aged 18-to-64 working in Suffolk County are employed full time
