

MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING OF  
THE BOSTON REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY  
HELD ON JULY 25, 1958

The Members of the Boston Redevelopment Authority met in adjourned session at the offices of the Authority, Room 350, 73 Tremont Street, Boston, Massachusetts, at 1:20 p.m. on July 25, 1958. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, and upon roll call those present and absent were as follows:

On motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED: that pursuant to a recommendation by the City Council, Wallace Orpint, Chief of Development, be instructed to check all City departments involved in demolition of abandoned buildings in the West End Area in order to establish an up-to-date, accurate list of the structures which are standing in the West End Project Area on the date of the execution of the demolition contract.

Mr. Colbert moved that the Authority award the demolition contract to the John J. Duane Company, Inc., of Quincy, Massachusetts, in the amount of \$937,000, as the lowest responsible bidder for the job as advertised\*. The motion was seconded by Mr. Massucco.


The Chairman read a message into the record that Monsignor Lally had called and stated that he wanted to be recorded at this meeting as voting for the lowest responsible bidder.
